Bedford Music Club's 50th season opens with a very special concert. Born in Bedford, Carolyn Sampson is now one of the world's leading sopranos. It is hard to think of a better pairing than with members of The King's Consort, one of the world's leading baroque ensembles. Their programme brings together some of the best vocal music by Purcell and Handel. with chamber works by Vivaldi, Purcell and the French composer Joseph Bodin de Boismortier.

With playing described in the press as 'alluring' and 'unforgettable', violinist Fenella Humphreys enjoys a busy career combining chamber music and solo work, with performances around the world. Accompanied by Bedford School's Head of Keyboard, **Robert Thompson**, she performs some of the finest violin repertoire by Schubert, Prokofiev and Fauré alongside Thomas Dunhill's less well-known, but equally wonderful Sonata.

Winner of the inaugural Eric Aubier International Trumpet Competition in October 2017, Matilda Llovd is making a reputation as one of the outstanding trumpeters of her generation. She has appeared as a soloist at the BBC Proms. with the BBC Concert Orchestra and London Mozart Players and is a Making Music UK Philip and Dorothy Green Young Artist. This concert draws together three centuries of writing for the trumpet, accompanied by prize-winning organist Jonathan Bunney.

Born in Bucharest, Florian Mitrea has been based in the UK for over a decade, and has won a host of prizes for his solo and chamber music performances. He has performed all over the world, including at Carnegie Hall and across Europe and Asia: Martha Argerich, among others, has praised the beauty of his playing. His programme includes some of the most technically challenging music in the solo piano repertoire.

Winners of the 2017 St Martin's Chamber Music Competition, the Manchester-based **Zelkova Ouartet** has established a reputation as one of the UK's up-and-coming string quartets. The quartet formed in 2016 and works regularly with their mentor Petr Prause, cellist of the Talich Quartet. Their programme brings together works from the rich and diverse repertoire of three of the best quartet composers: Mozart, Mendelssohn and Dvořák.

Baritone **Roderick Williams** needs no introduction. One of the finest baritones in the world, and an exquisite song performer he won the Singer of the Year Award in the 2016 Royal Philharmonic Society Awards and was awarded the OBE for services to music in June 2017. BBC Radio 3 New Generation Artist mezzo-soprano Kathryn Rudge was nominated in the Young Artist category of the prestigious RPS Awards 2016. They are joined at the piano by Bedford Music Club Artistic Director William Vann.
